Below are answers to common questions we receive about our Pawsitive Pals program.

What will I do as a Pawsitive Pals volunteer?

- You and your pet will visit our patients in their homes, long-term care facilities, or our inpatient units to provide companionship and comfort.

What are the requirements for me?

- You should be in good physical health, emotionally mature, stable, non-judgmental, and have a sincere desire to help.
- You will need to complete an orientation and a 2-day patient care volunteer training course.

What are the requirements for my dog?

- Your dog must have current pet therapy certification and insurance. The necessary insurance is included with certification at our approved agencies.

What if my dog is not yet certified?

- Your dog will need to be certified prior to becoming a Pawsitive Pals volunteer. Currently approved certification agencies include:
